






ENGINE HOOD

REMOVAL/INSTALLATION

NOTE: Prevent any damage of paintwork during hood removal or installation.

1. Disconnect battery (-) lead.
2. Open hood.



WARNING:

Support hood properly to prevent dropping onto maintenance personnel during removal.

3. Remove damper retaining rings.
4. Unscrew two bolts securing hood to hinges, remove bolts and washers.
5. Remove dampers.
6. Remove hood.



- Before torquing hinge bolts, adjust hood position as indicated in the following.
- Following installation, if necessary, perform setting of hood height adjustment pins and of shock absorbers as indicated in the following.

HOOD POSITION ADJUSTMENT

1. Partially unscrew hinge bolts.
2. Move hood laterally or longitudinally as necessary.
3. Lock hood in position by tightening the hinge bolts.
4. Check that hood position is satisfactory; otherwise, repeat operations stated at previous steps.
5. When hood position adjustment is complete, torque hinge bolts to prescribed torque. If necessary grease with prescribed products.

HOOD HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT PINS SETTING

1. Slightly loosen left or right adjustment pin securing nut.
2. Unscrew or screw adjustment pin as necessary.
3. Lock pin in position tightening adjustment pin secu-

ing nut.

4. Repeat above operations on opposite adjustment pin.
5. Check that setting has been carried-out properly, and repeat if necessary.

SHOCK ABSORBERS ADJUSTMENT

1. Slightly loosen left or right shock absorber securing nut.
2. Manually unscrew shock absorber as required.
3. Lock shock absorber in position by tightening nut.
4. Repeat above operations on opposite shock absorber.
5. Check that adjustment has been carried-out properly, and repeat if necessary.

HOOD RELEASE CONTROL

REMOVAL/INSTALLATION


1. Disconnect battery (-) lead.
2. Open engine hood.
3. Unscrew and remove hood release cable lock knob.
4. Acting from vehicle's interior, release retainer from hood release control lever.
5. Partially slide release control cable until off the front sheath, then remove front sheath.
6. Slide-off control cable from vehicle.



Following installation, adjust the hood release control cable as indicated in the following.

HOOD RELEASE CABLE ADJUSTMENT

1. Screw or unscrew cable stop knob as required.



ENGINE HOOD SAFETY LOCK

REMOVAL/INSTALLATION

1. Disconnect battery (-) lead.
2. Open engine hood.
3. Remove the two bolts and washers securing hood safety lock.
4. Remove the two rivets securing hood safety lock.
5. Remove hood safety lock.



TRUNK LID

REMOVAL/INSTALLATION

NOTE: Prevent any damage of paintwork during lid removal or installation.


1. Disconnect battery (-) lead.
2. Remove hinge plastic covers.



WARNING:

Support lid properly to prevent dropping onto maintenance personnel during removal.

4. Remove bolts and washers securing lid to hinges.
5. Remove trunk lid.



3. Disconnect electric cable.

SPRING ADJUSTMENT PLATE



- Before torquing the hinge bolts, adjust lid position as indicated in the following.
- Before re-connecting electric cables, check that wires are properly connected to connectors.
- After completion of installation, check lid opening spring for proper operation; adjust spring as indicated in the following, if required.

TRUNK LID POSITION ADJUSTMENT

1. Partially unscrew hinge bolts.
2. Move lid laterally or longitudinally as required.
3. Lock lid in position by torquing hinge bolts.
4. Check lid position is satisfactory, and repeat adjustment if required as stated in previous steps.
5. After adjustment, torque hinge bolts to prescribed torque. If necessary grease with prescribed products.


TRUNK LID OPENING SPRING ADJUSTMENT

1. Open trunk lid.
2. Release spring from adjustment plate.
3. Move spring hook on adjustment plate as required.

TRUNK LID RELEASE SOLENOID

REMOVAL/INSTALLATION

1. Disconnect battery (-) lead.
2. Remove trunk lid trim panel (refer to Group 66).
3. Remove two nuts and washers securing trunk lid release device.
4. Release trunk lid release device tie-rod from lock block.
5. Disconnect electric cable.
6. Remove trunk lid release device.
7. Remove two bolts and washers securing lock block.
8. Remove lock block.
9. Remove two bolts and washers securing lid lock.



10. Remove lid lock.



- Before final torquing of lid release control device and lid lock securing bolts, perform adjustment indicated in the following paragraph.
- Before re-connecting electric cables, check wires are properly connected to connectors.
- If necessary, grease with prescribed products.

ADJUSTMENT

1. Fix lock block in center position.
2. Partially unscrew bolts securing lid release device.
3. Move release device to left or right, as required.
4. Lock lid release device torquing attachment bolts.
5. Check lid for proper opening, and repeat adjustment if necessary.
6. If necessary, move lock block to left or right, as required.
